### RADSW X RADLAW X QPIRGs & CO ZINE EVENT - SOCIOHISTORICAL CONTEXT

In 2015, the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) released a roadmap of 94 steps to help achieve reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples. These 94 steps are known as the TRC Calls to Action. As a whole, the document holds accountable the many actors complicit in the horrors of residential schools, as well as the institutions that still interfere with Indigenous ways of life. Before reconciliation can even be considered, we need truth.

The sacred teachings are an essential part of Indigenous ecosystems and consciousness. The medicine wheel, the wampum diplomacy system, and the Creator's teachings all existed long before settlers arrived.

First Peoples had a way of life before colonization—one where women held the power. For centuries, women were the ones assigning leadership roles to men. The clan bloodline, its culture, and its spirituality are all gifts passed from mother to child.

The Creator gave Indigenous Peoples instructions to bury their weapons and choose peace and brotherhood over war. In good faith, First Peoples taught settlers their way of life, hoping to live in peace alongside Europeans. While Indigenous Nations living on Turtle Island believed in abundance and love, Europeans believed in scarcity and survival. Our governments were behind the residential school system and enforced segregation between Indigenous and non-Indigenous communities. Solidarity is a must. We cannot stay silent. It is silence that allows governments to continue invading and exploiting Indigenous lands.

#### CANADA IS UPHOLDING AN APARTHEID SYSTEM.

Today, residential schools still exist—but now, we call them prisons.

## MANY INDIGENOUS PEOPLES ARE OVERREPRESENTED IN YOUTH SERVICES AND THE PRISON SYSTEM, along with other minorities.

Community healing happens through solidarity—solidarity rooted in deep honesty and truth. To practice honesty, we have to be honest with ourselves. We need to connect, people to people. We are not robots—especially as social work and law students. We are in the people's business. We need to be real. We need to speak from the heart. We are living stories, meeting and connecting with one another. It's a powerful thing to truly hear another soul. Remember this: two mountains may never meet—but two people will. Mountains can be the revolutionary ideologies we dream about, or the Eurocentric capitalistic caste systems that try to wear us down. But people travel. Their words travel too—and those words build movements.

"Reconciliation cannot happen. At least, not between the Canadian and Quebec states and Indigenous peoples. There never was 'conciliation' in the first place—how could reconciliation happen? The colonial nation-states (and, frankly, all nation-states) are by design made to control their territories through violence and repress ways of life that do not replicate capitalism, colonialism, imperialism, sexism, queerphobia, etc.

It is no coincidence that Indigenous peoples are incarcerated at disproportionate rates and pipelines are still being built on unceded territories. The TRC is but an empty symbolic distraction. We settlers of all colors must reckon with what is really required to abolish the state and all the hierarchical structures of power.

To liberate ourselves from the paradigm engendered by the Treaty of Westphalia, the Doctrine of Discovery—terra nullius. Everyone would benefit from societies that do not overwork us while destroying the Earth in the process. But, to get there, we need to create the economic, social, and political structures that can replace the old world, as well as international networks of solidarity. That would be reconciliation."
